New Business

Calamity Days-A board member brought up that she is not in favor of adding days on to the end of the year, it should be done before the end of the year. Proposed an amendment to previous board minutes to include this comment.

Superintendent's Recommendations

A board member (Mrs.Schoonover) voiced that she is not in favor of students losing 12 hours of instructional time. Mr. Yohey explained that this change is in connection with the new laws according to the state of Ohio and that we are over those required hours. The district looked at how those hours can best be used and decided to take advantage of the surplus hours and use them as PD. The 12 hours is less than what we are currently doing, not 12 hours less than the minimum. The board has already approved the change to the calendar for next year.

Comments regarding the decrease of 12 hours for next year's calendar. Mr. Yohey responded to this by acknowledging that the hours will contribute to better PD for teachers to be able to better prepare students.

Board Discussion

Question: How do we record the board minutes? Minutes are recorded during regular meetings until the minutes have been approved then the next minutes are recorded over. Board development sessions are not recorded. However, it was determined you cannot hear the recordings so they are no longer recorded.

How then is it determined what is important to include in the minutes? Ronda records minutes using notes she took during the meeting. Minutes should be clear and detailed enough for anyone who did not attend the meeting to be informed of discussion that took place. Suggestion made for all members to take minutes. House Bill 264

Opportunity to improve fiscal picture by exploring LED light fixture replacement program. Allows districts to fund projects(small capital improvements) then use the money from the energy savings to pay back the short term debt. At this point it is exploratory with some proposals in about a month.
