### **June, 2014 Building Concerns**

#### **High School:**

- emails sent to specific teachers - double standard? accountability?
  - for some students, their class doesn't matter to graduate
  - what are you doing for their grade to improve in class
- exam schedule
  - no time worked in for teachers to do grades b/c PD
- student was expelled but was in attendance at prom, graduation, sr. breakfast?
  - all was in line with past occurrences. Katie received clarification from district.
- lack of consistent discipline
- EdInsight
  - concern and being addressed by Scott
  - *New expectations will be clarified at the start of the new school year.*

#### **Middle Schools:**

##### **Rapid**

- PARRC test concern
- Stress Test: not given any advanced notice to teachers

#### **Elementary Schools:**

- kindergarten assessment coming down from the state
  - huge amount of social observation to do
  - adding minutes to the day ?
  - day extended ...
  - where will this fit in?
  - possible suggestion... adjust dates on curriculum map...
    - possibly not start curriculum map until later so that it would include the hours to address these concerns
    - flexibility?

#### **General Concerns:**

- overall student attendance was VERY LOW Monday June 9th

- amount of days that teachers were pulled out during the last few weeks
- technology working consistently is a worry, especially for new online tests and new math/science programs
