## September, 2013 Building Concerns

#### High School:

- The reps will meet with Mr. Stoddard monthly meeting to discuss building concerns
- The possibility of a resource room for students requiring services for tests (small group, read aloud, etc. was discussed
- There was concern over the scheduling of CCR pre-tests and how some students may not be taking testing seriously

#### Middle Schools:

## **Elementary Schools:**

  - o could this be scheduled after school hours: after 4 PM
