- Mr. Yohey thanked the Oak Hills staff for a smooth start to the new school year.
- Mr. Yohey applauded Mr. Harold and Mr. Melvin for their handling of the safety issue at Oakdale last week.

- House Bill 597 will not be voted on until after the November election. This bill would repeal the common core standards in Ohio. The Oak Hills Board of Education opposes this bill.

- Mrs. Schoonover voiced concern about the technology issues in the schools over the past two weeks.
