VI. Board of Education Meetings

Board Development Meeting:

- June 15th
 - Board started off in Executive session for one hour.
 - Technology update: currently ordering for upcoming school year.
 - Mr. Beckmeyer: New phone system Voice over ip is currently up and running at District office and RRMS. All schools should be done by June 27th.
 - Middle School Science update: a team of people are working to create an advanced course for 8th graders to take that would count as an elective at high school but add more rigor to the current science course.
 - Mr. Yohey thanked all of the teachers and administrators that have worked on this task.
 - Mr. Bain- update on possibly refinancing the current bond to a lower interest rate which would save tax dollars.

Board Meeting 7/13/15:

- Mr. Yohey and Board members acknowledged Bob Sehlhorst for his dedication to the school district.
- Discussion related to retire/rehire: Comments regarding if they should get their same positions and department head positions.

- Mr. Bain shared that HB64 is allowing additional funds for the next two fiscal years. Year 1- 900,000, Year 2- 453,000.
- IHARC -revitalization group which has committed to 300,000 towards the renovation of the auditorium has currently donated 15,000. They are behind 15,000 as well. More discussion will occur when the board learns more about their funding.\
- Elementary Conference schedule was approved. Conference schedule follow up (2) four hour nights and (1) 3 hour night in the fall; (1) 3 hour night in the spring (1/2 hour break within each night

- Threat Assessment Update: Middle and High School Assessments completed by students and reviewed to determine needs. Elementary- teachers will compete forms for each student 3 times a year. Board Member expressed need to present this to OHEA.

- Professional Learning Framework progress presented to board. Board has expressed an interest in what is happening during the Professional Learning PD days.
- Discussion regarding building heat concerns. If the heat index is above 104 degrees for a prolonged time, the district will discuss whether to close or dismiss students early.
