3319.11 and 3319.08 which outline the criteria for continuing contracts. The law in this area changed January 1, 2011. We agreed that a teacher is eligible for a continuing contract if he or she has taught 3 out of 5 years in the district and seven years total (which includes the time as a resident educator) as well as the rest of the criteria outlined in 3319.08 such as a master's degree. Those teachers with licenses before January 1, 2011 only need three out of five years in the district.

- Insurance is not clear
 - But it is understood that students get two free repairs... loosely
 - \$20.00 yearly covers \$180.00 of coverage
 - Discount for multiple children??? Families with lots of kids not right now
 - Accountability:
 - Working on it BIG time now!
 - Insurance is an option:
 - Like car insurance and a bank account: up to \$180.00
 - Use it or lose it
 - Exception for insurance is lost or stolen = not covered by the insurance
 - If you don't have insurance ---- district covers \$60.00
 - Gamble to not have it
 - IF teachers have anything else to add... please let them know!
 - FAQ Q/A section on website: ohlsd.us/chromebooks
 - Also found on ohlsd.org
 - Great place to send parents to look/get responses from now on
- Where does the \$ go for the insurance ?
 - General fund...account for parts
 - Goes back to account where repairs come from (supply account)
- If there is a repair needed:
 - Teacher submits a ticket?
 - Teacher submits the tix
 - If habitual will allow teacher to recognize this issue
 - Student goes to media center to get a loaner
- In addition:
 - Emergency Walkie Talkie/Radio needs assessment possibly one per building
